- D. Document 10 of the 15 Woodruff Bigfoot sightings (see Bigfoot game card) _____
- E. In addition to the above, participate as a troop in 7 of the following: _____
 - 1 Attend the Sunday Opening Campfire Program _____
 - 2 Participate in at least 1 shower house cleaning _____
 - 3 Host or attend an inter-Troop cracker barrel _____
 - 4 As a troop, participate in the Woodruff recycling program and put your bin out on Saturday _____
 - 5 Conduct a flag ceremony in-site or at a meal-time assembly _____
 - 6 Carry the Troop flag to 80% of meal-time assemblies' _____
 - 7 Wear full scout field uniform to 80% of evening meals _____
 - 8 At least one Scout participates in an "older Scout program" (Laurel Mountain, News Team, Woodruff Xtreme, Whitewater Challenge) _____
 - 9 Have a troop entry in the Friday afternoon camp-wide game _____
 - 10 All scouts and adult leaders take at least 2 showers during the week (the lake does not count!) _____
