To earn The Woodruff Firemaster Award complete 4 of the 5 fire building achievements below. All requirements must be completed during Periods 6 or 7 in the Outdoor Skills Program Area under the supervision of an Outdoor Skills staff member who can sign off on each achievement when complete.

_____ **One Match Fire.** Start a fire using one match. You may only attempt one “one match fire” per program day.

_____ **Steel Wool and Battery.** Start a fire using steel wool and a nine-volt battery.

_____ **Magnifying Lens.** Start a fire by focusing sunlight through a curved lens such as that found on a magnifying glass. You may also use items such as the baseplates of a compass, eyeglasses, a camera lens, binoculars, telescope or a water bottle.

_____ **Flint and Steel.** Start a fire by flint and steel. You may use traditional flint and steel, ferro rod or magnesium stick – devices that produce sparks. You may not use a fueled sparking device.

_____ **Bow Drill.** Start a fire by using a bow drill (fireboard, bow and drill) or alternatively using a hand drill or fire plow. This achievement must be a wood on wood friction fire.
